What I should know by the end of this unit of learning

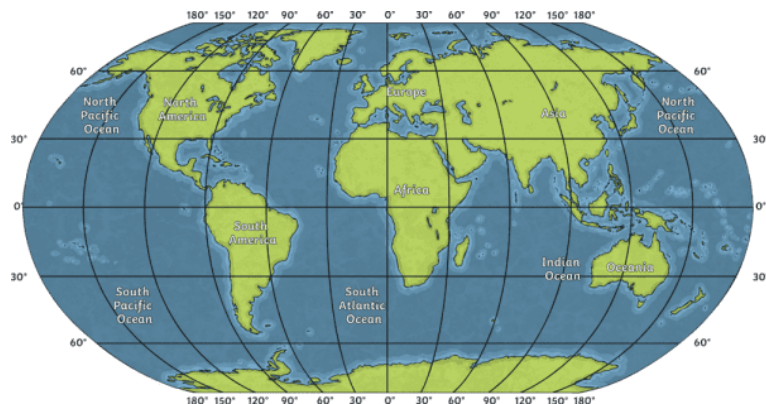
I can compare a rural and an urban region within the UK
